		All infants are exclusively breastfed up to 6 months

		All children are given 1 dose of Vit A starting at 6-11 mos/1-5 yrs are given Vit A capsules 2x /yr
	Survival: Maternal Health	All births are attended by trained personnel
		All pregnant women get at least 4 complete pre-natal check ups.
		All mothers are fully immunized against tetanus
		All pregnant or lactating mothers get vit A & iron supplements
		All pregnant women at risk get emergency obstetrical care
		All pregnancies are spaced at least 3-5 years apart
	Development: Education	All 3-5 yr old children attend ECCD programme
		All children 6-15 yr. old complete basic education through regular or alternative delivery modes
		All children graduating in elementary school attain mastery level of nationally defined competencies
		All illiterate parents or caregivers are enrolled in functional literacy programme
