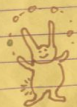


Nottingham Games

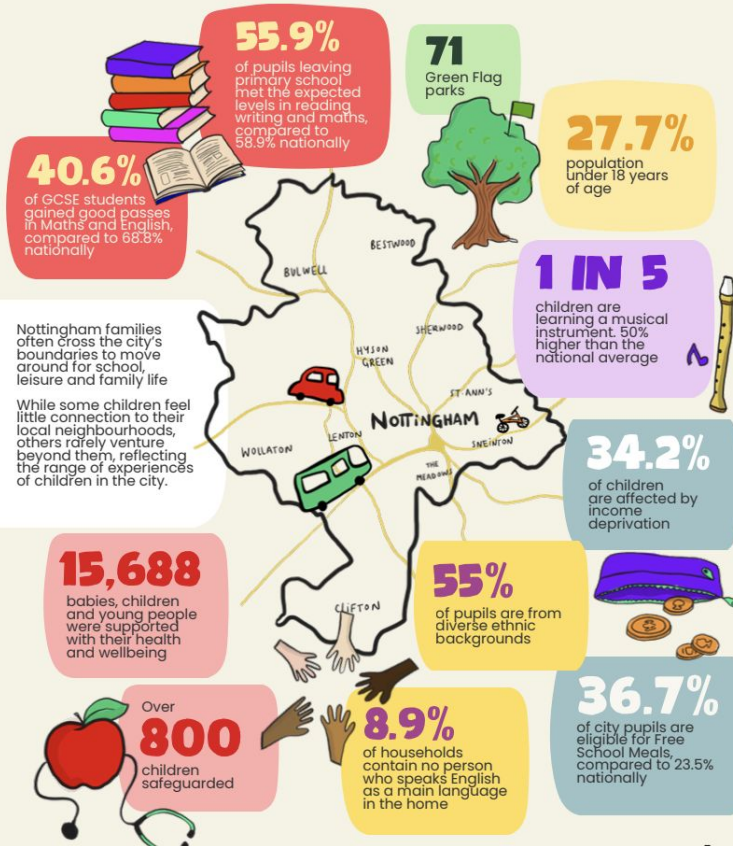
